Add end caps when installing armour guard!





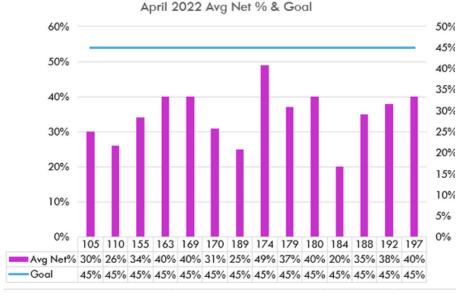

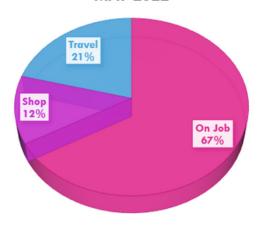
