## Safety Meeting



### Recap on last months roof and harness safety meeting:

- Assess the roof and weather from the ground / ladder to make sure it is safe to continue.
- Harness attachment points in a PFA system should be in the center of the back, near the shoulder level.
- Anchors should be directly above where you are working to prevent a swing fall

Be aware and mark any rooftop or landscaping features that could be

hazardous.

## Gutter Do's and Don'ts



PLEASE tamp down the ground after installing drain tile. After your are done, the ground should lay flat - no sort of bump. We have had many complaints and service calls to come tamp and spread grass seed on drain tile installs.



Gutters should always be installed under the drip edge. We returned to this job after leak complaints only to find out the gutter was installed incorrectly. These are service calls that are very easily avoidable if you take your time and do things the correct way.

Walk arounds should ALWAYS be competed before AND after an installation is complete. If you come across something weird or have questions - ASK. Ask the estimator, ask the homeowner, ask the office as a last step. Better to wait and ask so we do not have to return if the homeowner is unhappy.

#### T-Sheets Do's and Don'ts \*\*IMPORTANT INFORMATION BELOW!!

- Should only be punched in when working, any personal stops **must** be approved and employee would need to be punched out
- Stops should be indicated in notes (getting gas, bathroom breaks, etc)
- Each punch should have the job name and if it is complete or incomplete (SEVERAL punches haven't had notes at all. Whether you are a foreman or not you should ALWAYS have notes in your clock in/out.)
- If shop time is more than loading notes need added!
- Lunch periods will be paid for employees that eat on-site and are not to exceed 30 minutes. If a longer lunch break is needed or if an off-site lunch (Drive-Thru's Included) is desired **it must first be approved**, all employees are to punch out during that period.
- All punches must take place at the shop or place of installation. Punches outside of the shop or work sites are not approved. If arrangements have been approved to be dropped off somewhere other than the job or the next work site, the punch out will be at the time of leaving the last job site or the shop will be unpaid.



Sway bars **MUST** be used on the trailers at all times!






## Get to know the crew!
