# Safety Meeting Recap



## Gutter Machine - Learning and Maintenance

- Always thoroughly inspect the gutter machine to make sure it is clean inside and out before extruding gutter.
- Make sure the 6 rollers on the box assembly are down for 6" gutter assembly.
- Dry lube should be used while spraying shafts and pins to keep the machine running smoothly.
- Do not wear loose clothing, jewelry, etc. that could become entangled in moving parts of the machine when in operation.

# Do's and Don'ts



DO **always** add end caps to armour guard installs.

Don't be lazy and skip this step - you should catch these in your walk-arounds after the job has been completed if you didn't do it at the time of install. We have seen an increase of no endcaps again. Armour Guard comes with a no clog guarantee - if any debris gets in the gutter, we go clean it at no cost to the customer. Please be sure to add end caps and complete walk-arounds before AND after each install.

on Mason!

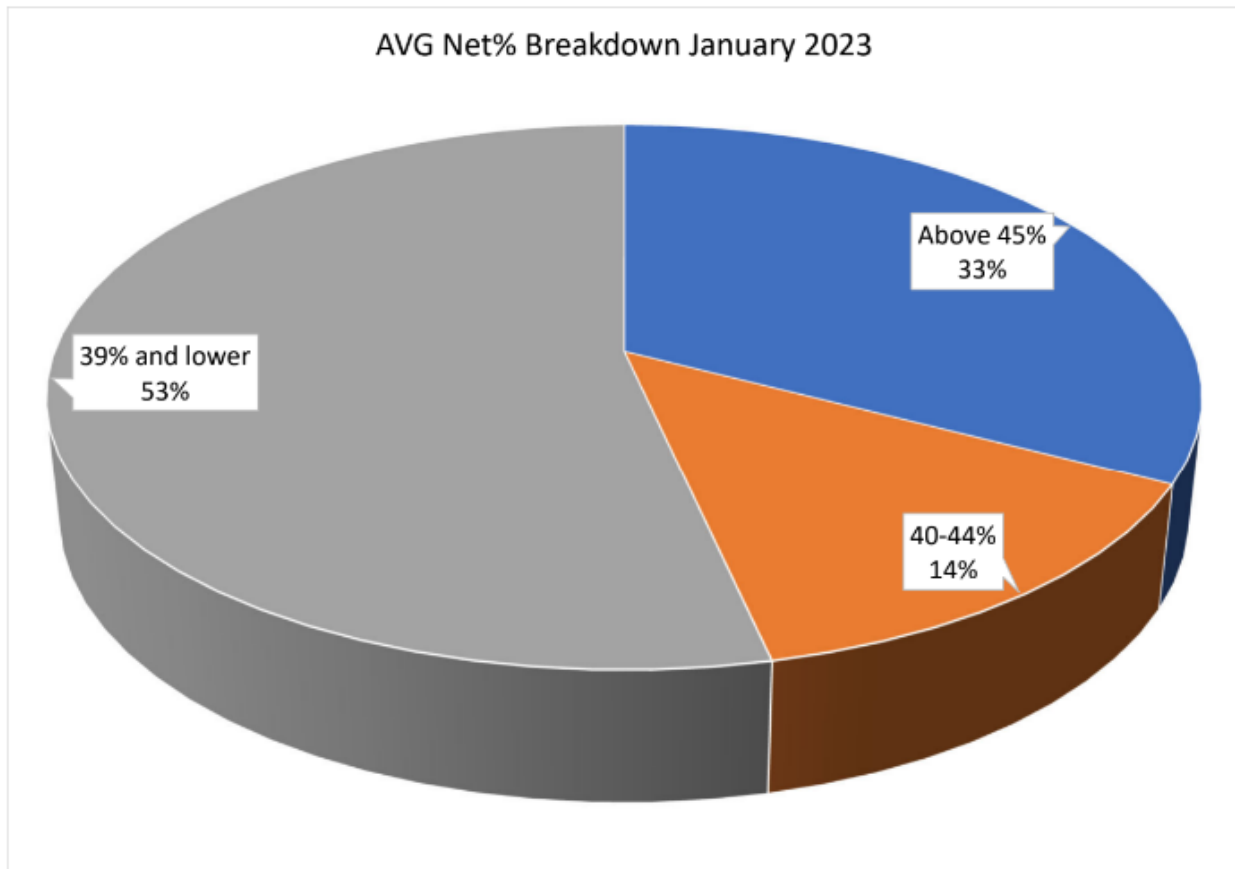
