Falling Object Hazards

Secure all tools and materials to prevent them from falling on people below. Do not hang or drape any items over guardrails. Unless items are being used for work in progress, keep all tools and materials at least 3 feet from any leading edges. Consider using tool lanyards to prevent tools from falling.

When working at heights do not keep any items in pockets that aren't zipped or securely closed, including items like cell phones, pens, or small tools.

Always wear hard hats when work is being performed overhead or when other work conditions call for it.

Do's and Don'ts



DON'T pull/rip on drip edge. We cannot continue to replace drip edge due to it being damaged during our installations. The gutters also won't work properly resulting in leaks or damage to the home. You should NEVER leave drip edge looking like this.



DON'T cut down the drip edge this much.
Only an inch or two is necessary













Get To Know The Crew








Lets Talk Numbers
